What to Bring:

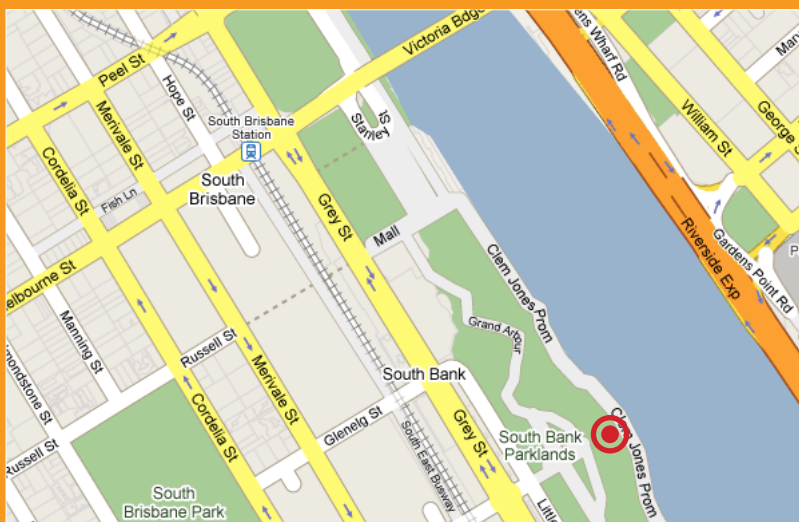
- Lots of water. Taps and shops are nearby for refills.
